COVID PROTOCOL	<p>At this time the following is required by Manitoba Public Health:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All individuals entering the facility above the age of 5 years old must wear a mask. Masks can be removed while eating and drinking. • Athletes may remove the mask only while it is their turn on the equipment to train or perform. • All individuals over the age of 18 must produce proof of double vaccination status to enter the competition facility. • All individuals between the age of 12-17 must produce proof of one dose or a negative test result within 72 hours of entry. <i>Note: We have received indication that this will change to two doses in early 2022 however we have received no indication if testing will be permitted in lieu.</i> • No vaccination requirements for 11 and under currently. <i>Note: We have received indication that there will be a vaccination requirement in 2022 however no specific timeline or indication of requirements have been obtained.</i> • All hotels do not require vaccination to stay at the hotel however to use the amenities (i.e., fitness centers, pools, restaurants, etc) proof of double vaccination is required. <p>An update to COVID protocol will be included in Bulletin #2. However, any urgent or significant changes mandated by Manitoba Public Health will be communicated to PSOs as received.
