4. Program areas

4.1 Gymnaestrada

- 2019 BC Gymnaestrada
 - Registration update: 24 clubs, 4 of which are rhythmic clubs and 2 from Alberta.
 - Approximately 440 participants.
 - Workshop topic ideas from the organizing committee (OC) were brought to the committee; feedback provided and will be communicated to the OC.
- 2020 BC Gymnaestrada
 - Application to host deadline has been extended and will be communicated in future GymBC Weeklys.

4.2 2019 GFA Retreat

- Update: Several keynote speakers have been contacted; GFA Manager will keep the committee apprised about responses.
- Workshop ideas brought up included: aerial silks, partner group.work, circuit creativity, parkour, etc.
- Discussed tapping into local experts to help fill sessions Keara will compile requested topics and sent to the committee. Committee to help suggest or nominate BC people who would be a good fit.

- 4.3 Circus Arts Program (Emerging Program)
 - GymBC will be forming an Aerial Arts working group by sourcing knowledgeable persons from our clubs. This working group will be created to participate in a preliminary review on a certification program and curriculum developed by the Vancouver Circus School.
 - If the materials area approved, a pilot course will be run to evaluate content.

4.4 Canadian Gymnastics Week

- 2019 Dates: February 3 9, 2019
- Future Date Change: From 2020 onwards, CGW will change to October, during the week before Thanksgiving.

4.5 Interclub Program

- Discussion on revised major/minor error chart. Updates made.
- Discussion on video aids and YouTube video examples to accompany the Interclub Adjudicator Training – GFA committee expertise needed.
