2022 Western Canadian Championships

18 - 24 APR 2022 WINNIPEG, MB

Twisters Invitational will be the only trial event for Westerns. Selection to the Westerns team for each category will be based 100% on rankings from this event only. **Petitions will not be accepted.**

Categories included at the 2022 Westerns are **Aspire 1-2, CCP L8-9-10.**

For All Levels

- Top 5 or 7 All-Around ranked athletes in their respective age groups make up the team.
- In the event of a tie for Team BC selection, the highest scoring athlete using their top 3 event scores at trials will prevail. In the below example, Athlete Y is named to the team.

- The ranked order of each athlete will be used to determine the team coaches.
- If any Western province does not send a full team, wildcard spots become available. Availability of wildcards is only known after provinces officially register for Westerns with the host. There is a maximum of 2 wild cards per level per province. BC may or may not accept all wildcard positions.
- A minimum travelling score of 34.00 will be applied in levels 8, 9, 10 and Aspire 1, 2. The score must be achieved at the trial competition. If the trial event becomes virtual, no minimum travelling score will be needed.
- One non-travelling alternate will be named for each team following the same selection principles as above. Alternates are expected to order the Team BC uniform and attend the training camp.

Training Camp

The Team BC Westerns training camp date is to be determined, likely on Sunday April 17th, 2022. The location will be at one of the clubs in Zone 3, 4 or 5. The camp will be planned as a one-day camp. This training camp will be mandatory for all team members (athletes, coaches, GBC funded judges and support staff), unless otherwise arranged.

2022 Canadian Championships

MAY 26 – 31, 2022 RICHMOND, BC

The 2022 BC Championships will be the only trial event for Canadian Championships and will take place over 2 days (Friday and Sunday). Each day is weighed equally (50% each) and selection to the Canadians team for each category will be based 100% on rankings from this event only. **Petitions will not be accepted.**

Categories included at the 2022 Canadians are **HP Novice-Junior-Senior and CCP L9-10.**

For All Levels

- Top 6 All-Around ranked athletes in their respective age groups make up the team.
- In the event of a tie for Team BC selection, the highest scoring athlete using their top 3 event scores each day at trials will prevail. In the below example, Athlete Y is named to the team.

- The ranked order of each athlete will be used to determine the team coaches.
- A minimum travelling score of 68.00 over 2-day will be applied in levels 9 and 10. The score must be achieved at the trial competition. If the trial event becomes virtual, no minimum travelling score will be needed.
- One non-travelling alternate will be named for each team following the same selection principles as above. Alternates are expected to order the Team BC uniform and attend the training camp.
